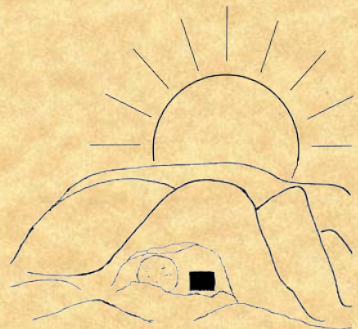


But he was wounded for our

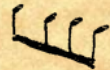

Anne and Larry were married in August 1991. In December of that year, we sent out our first Christmas cards, homemade using WordPerfect 5.1 on a 286-class computer running DOS, and printed monochrome on an H-P IIP, the first of the personal laser printers. These first cards were 1/4-size, front, back, and inside all on one side of a single sheet of colored paper, folded twice and mailed in invitation envelopes. In a number of years since (not all; sometimes we've used Scripture cards printed and sold retail), we've also created our own card. The hope is that these greetings would glorify the Messiah and add in some small way to your Christmas celebration.

This year's effort is a larger-size re-imagining of the very first card we sent out in 1991. We hope you enjoy it.
