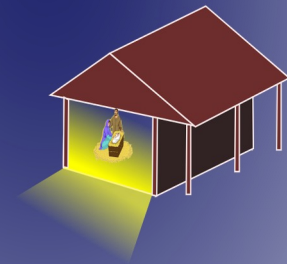


*For God so loved the world,
